Anne E. Tebo Certified as ABMLI Diplomate

WASHINGTON, DC—December 3, 2008—Anne E. Tebo, Ph.D., Assistant Professor, Department of Pathology, University of Utah, and Assistant Medical Director of Immunology, ARUP Laboratories, Salt Lake City, Utah, is now a certified Diplomate of the American Board of Medical Laboratory Immunology (ABMLI). Dr. Tebo received her Ph.D. from the Institute of Tropical Medicine, Eberhard Karls Univeristät, Tübingen, Germany. To earn the ABMLI credential, Dr. Tebo first met rigorous educational and experiential eligibility requirements and then passed a comprehensive written examination. She has demonstrated the knowledge and skills necessary to direct laboratories engaged in the practice of medical laboratory immunology.

The ABMLI was established in 1975 and is one of three boards of the American College of Microbiology administering highly stringent certification programs. Certification by the ABMLI is recognized by federal and state governmental agencies as a significant component toward meeting licensure requirements for high complexity laboratory directors and is recognized under the final rule of the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA).

The American College of Microbiology is the component of the American Academy of Microbiology responsible for accreditation of postdoctoral training programs, certification of microbiologists and immunologists, and other programs consistent with its mission of providing leadership in promoting the high quality and ethical practice of the microbiology and immunology professions for the benefits of human, animal, and environmental well-being.
