f1: Schistosoma Antibody IgG by ELISA

Positive - IgG antibodies to Schistosoma detected, which may suggest current or past infection. This test cannot distinguish between current or resolved, past infection. Serologic cross-reactivity can occur in individuals with other helminth infections. When serum antibodies are positive, the presence of Schistosoma ova in stool or urine should be evaluated by microscopy. This test should not be used to monitor for cure because patients remain seropositive after successful treatment and/or infection clearance.
