

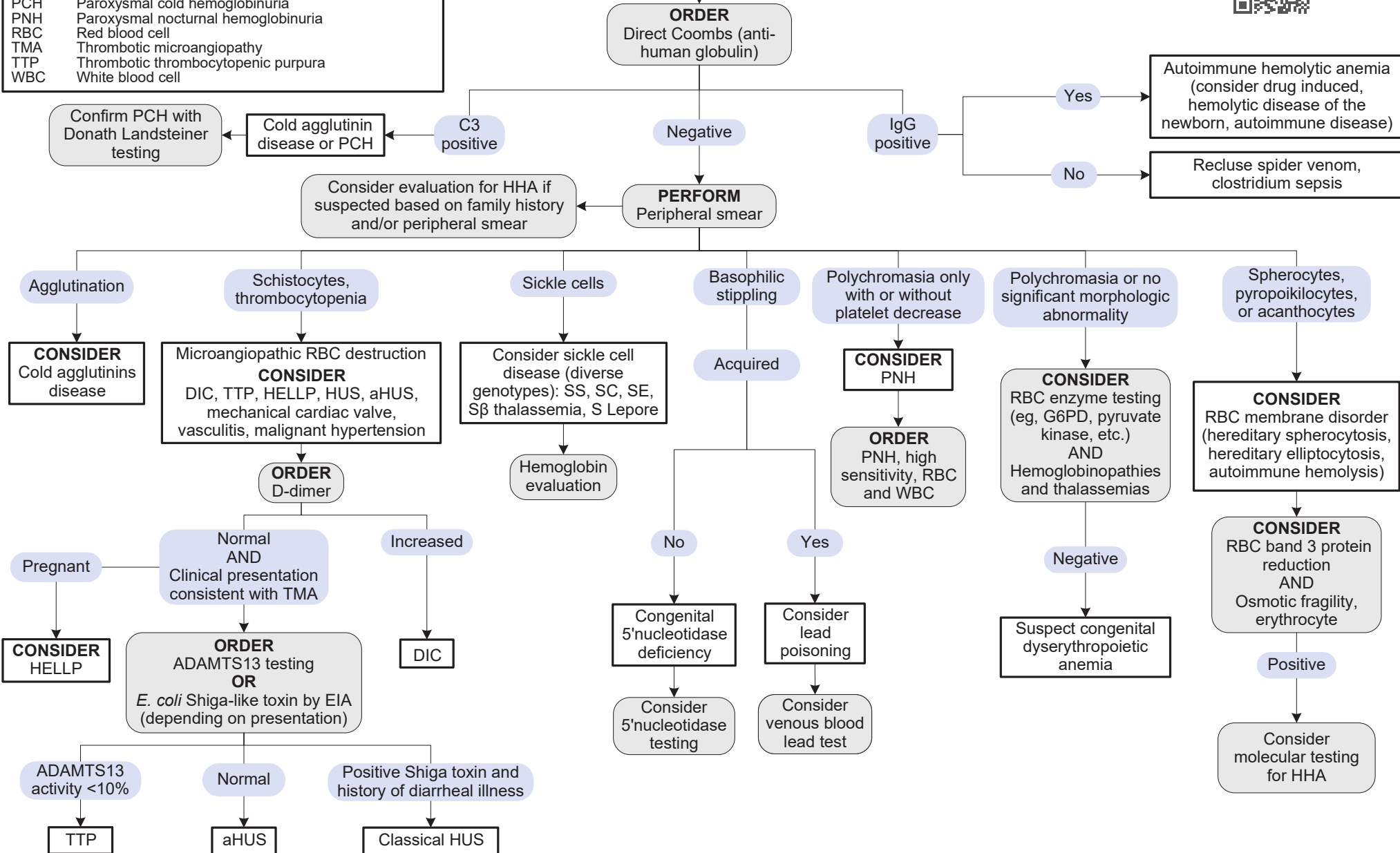

INDICATIONS FOR TESTING
 Signs of anemia hemolysis:
 • Elevated reticulocyte count, lactate dehydrogenase, and bilirubin
 • Low haptoglobin
