Automation

ARUP is one of the most automated laboratories in the United States.

- Chain conveyors transport tubes from Specimen Processing workstations.
- Interface robotic systems read tube barcodes and transfer tubes from transport tubes to pucks.
- Automated cameras utilize optical character-recognition technology to identify mislabeled specimens.
- MagneMover rapidly moves pucks to specific destinations with high precision and virtually no moving parts.

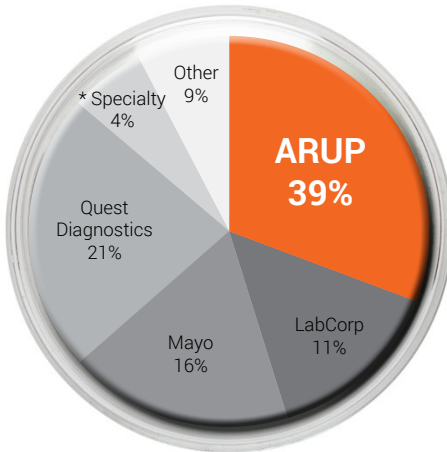


The new high-speed specimen processing track, which went live in 2015, enhances ARUP's ability to monitor, store, and receive specimens.

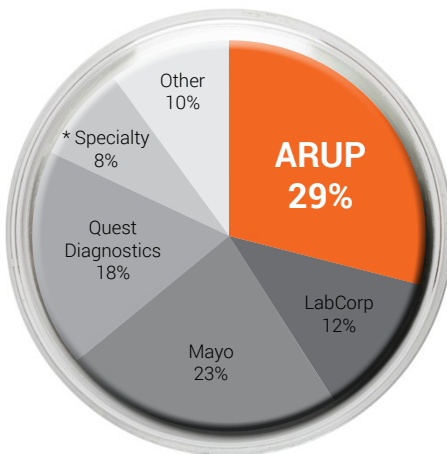
